§ Weighed down by wisteria, The Vyne, a 16th-century house, rests in the honey-hued conservation village of Eydon on the border of Northamptonshire and Oxfordshire.



The house has many historical features with a welcoming west facing walled garden.



We are within easy reach of the M40 and M1, Banbury, Brackley, Daventry, Warwick, Stratford upon Avon, Oxford, Northampton, Milton Keynes and Birmingham.

Situated on the Macmillan Walk other nearby attractions include the Silverstone Circuit, Cannons

Ashby, Upton House, Sulgrave Manor, the Stratford RSC Theatres, Warwick Castle, Towcester Race Course and Bicester Village Retail Park.

Accommodation consists of 2 bedrooms:
